
2025 Taipei Fringe Festival Autonomous Venue Program

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Guling Street Avant-garde Theatre Second Floor Art and Culture Space



After 30 months of renovation, Taipei historic building Guling Street Avant-garde Theatre has returned to the Fringe autonomous venue program. We'd like to welcome artists from everywhere to submit their applications with open arms!

Located within 5 minutes walking distance from MRT Chiang Kai-shek Memorial Hall station, the Art and Culture Space is a small exhibition space with audience capacity of 40 to 60 seats and a rehabilitated historic building charisma for you to experience. Guling Street Avant-garde Theatre is a former-police-station-rehabilitated avant-garde theatre, where you can utilize the space and equipment which includes not only rental-free (****)—a.k.a. your budget saver— professional theatre lighting and sound systems, but also a house team who can advise you on what to prepare before going into the theatre as well as being your production consultant when it comes to administration or technical related issues. Besides,

submitting for "Guling Street Avant-garde Theatre Annual Selection Program" might grant you the access to the experimental theatre for one week without rental fees which can contribute to your creation in the following year.

Reminder:

- # The principle of the production proposal should be quality before quantity. There's no limits in formation as long as the creation concept is clearly communicated. The production proposal is not part of the evaluation but merely a tool for the judges to know your creation concept beforehand. Please keep your proposal within 10 pages.
- # Selection for this program does not rely on proposals submitted, hence we strongly suggest preserving interview time. Online interviews can be arranged for those who can't attend the interview in person. Please let us know in advance if you need an online interview.
- # Only for those who can't attend the interview, whether online or in person, proposals will be used for the selection process.

[How to Apply]

1. February 11 (12:00) - 27 (18:00): Application period. Please upload the proposal and

fill out the application form. The proposal must include brief introduction of the team,

production detail, budget plan, production schedule, introduction of the team members

and so on.

2. March 3 (18:00): Interview sequence will be notified by email.

3. March 5: Interview will take place at the Guling Street Avant-garde Theatre, 10 minutes

for each team.

4. Prior to 18:00, March 10: Announcement of application results.

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Other Notice

1. The spirit of the autonomous venue program is to allow a more flexible way for the

venue team and creators to work together. The house team can communicate directly

with the creators regarding venue space, their aesthetics and operating philosophy as

well as how to utilize available time slots with strategy in order to achieve maximum

benefits for all parties. Please show mutual respect to achieve the common goal of

running a successful show.

2. Autonomous venue applicants should still follow the Fringe registration guideline and

submit online registration forms. Once selected, the house will inform the Fringe team

to import coordinated performing time slots into the system via website content

management system.

3. Selected applicants should follow the Fringe standard performance guidelines (usage

time, no use of fire, etc.) and coordinate with the venue team regarding performance

and technical related details under the Fringe existing guidelines. Selected applicants

should attend Technical and Front of House Coordination Meeting with the Fringe

- team and the venue team before their first show to discuss requests and requirements and seek suggestion and advice from hosting parties if needed.
- 4. Selected applicants should still arrange technical and front of house administrative personnel to ensure performances and audiences are tended.
- 5. The Fringe is still the organizing party for this event and if applicants have other collaborative ideas that would like to propose to the venue management during autonomous venue usage period, please communicate with the Fringe venue manager in advance.
- 6. Applicants should apply for one autonomous venue only, whether it be Guling Street Avant-garde Theatre or other available venues. The Fringe reserves the rights to cancel applicants' qualifications if they applied for more than one venue.
